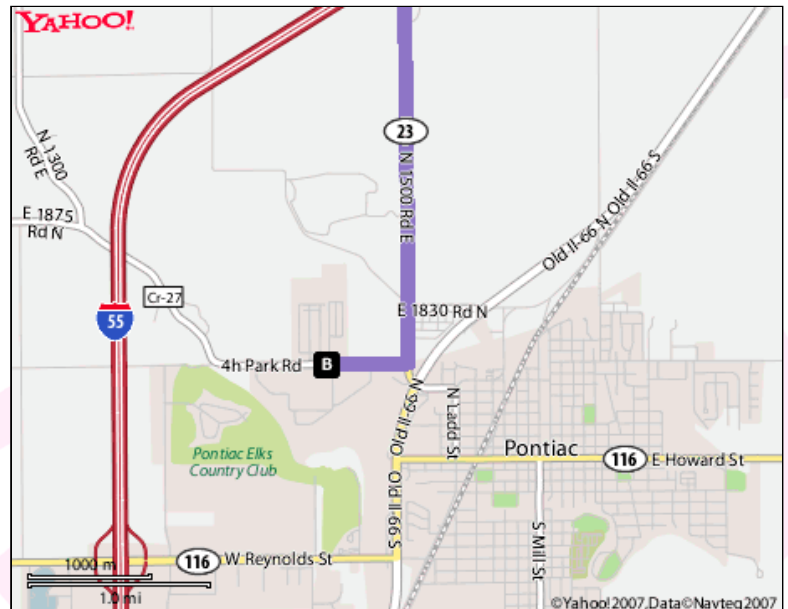




The next performance driving event is approaching: *Women's Day Driving Event*

Coming From North & Northwest Illinois

- Head south on I55 until you reach exit 201, IL Rte. 23.
- Take IL Rte. 23 south, (left hand turn) toward Pontiac, for 2 miles to 4H Park Road (aka 1800 N Road).
- Turn right onto 4H Park Road for 3/10 mile, Caterpillar employee entrance, (East Gate) is on the left.

Coming From The South

- Head north on I55 until you reach exit 201, IL Rte. 23.
- Take IL Rte. 23 south, (right hand turn), toward Pontiac, for 2 miles to 4H Park Road (aka 1800 N Road).
- Turn right onto 4H Park Road for 3/10 mile, Caterpillar employee entrance, (East Gate) is on the left.

Overview: This event caters to all of our female club members of all ages. It's meant to teach our ladies how to drive a stick shift, how to handle a Viper (or the car they choose to bring), and how to drive an autocross course. It caters to all novice drivers. It is not a competitive event. Gentlemen are free to come and watch/help. This event will take place in the large parking lot of the Caterpillar plant in Pontiac, Illinois. This event will occur rain or shine (unless an extraordinary downpour occurs). Lodging is suggested above if you choose to arrive the night before. If you are towing your car, there will plenty of room to park tow vehicles and trailers right next to the autocross course. We have arranged to have port-o-potties available right near the course. Several large tents will be erected to keep us out of the hot sun. We will break for lunch just before 12:00pm. Lunch will be complimentary for everyone attending and will be provided at the venue. Several coolers will be on hand, water is free to everyone. Spectators are welcome at no charge.

Also Needed: Please fill out a registration form and mail the payment before the event. The registration form is available on the IL VCA website or it can be emailed to you. If it's very close to the event, contact us so we know you're coming, we can fill out the forms at the event. Advance registration is appreciated.

Helpful Info: Items that may make the event more enjoyable and comfortable may include sunglasses, hat, suntan lotion, towel, folding chair, and umbrella (for sun and rain). Other items that might be of use are tire pressure gauge, driving gloves, and driving shoes. At the event, there are many folks eager to lend a helping hand with anything if need!

Details:

This event will take our ladies on a stepped and enjoyable learning experience that will teach them the Viper (or any car) is not that hard to drive at its limits. For those who don't yet know how to drive stick, instruction will be on hand for them, we'll take all the time we need. There will also be little exercises setup in the lot, we know you'll like it. The exercises get the tires screeching in a controlled and safe environment. Instructors will be in all cars to teach you how to drive the car. Later in the afternoon, the exercises will be combined into a course, so everyone will get a chance to drive a full autocross course. No helmet will be required for this event (though you're free to use one). Everyone is also required to wear closed toed shoes (you can however wear short sleeved shirts and short pants). When you arrive, simply check-in and we'll take it from there! The entire event is free, lunch is free too. You'll have a great time!
