Driver Safety Requirements

All participants will comply with each and every rule and requirement identified below or associated with any driving event. It is mandatory that you inspect your car before each event & preceding each run on the track, drag-strip, or autocross. Alcohol/drugs are not permitted at any performance driving events, this includes spectators. Safety is the ultimate responsibility of the driver. Please also consider the listed recommended items.

Autocross & Drag Racing Events	
Class	Required Equipment
All Classes (Super Stock, SRT, Super SRT, and Unlimited)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be at least 16 years of age, possess a valid driver's license, and valid auto insurance • Vehicles should be in good working order with no leaks, problems, or safety issues • There will be no loose parts/articles in the vehicle (radar detector, loose change, cups, floor mats, etc...) • Helmets are required. Must be SNELL/DOT approved and no older than year 2000. No motorcycle helmets allowed • Long sleeve cotton shirt and long pants or jeans (drag only) • Enclosed toed shoes (preferably leather)
Road Course Events	
Class	Required Equipment
All Classes (Super Stock, SRT, Super SRT, and Unlimited)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be at least 16 years of age, possess a valid driver's license, and valid auto insurance • Vehicles should be in good working order with no leaks, problems, or safety issues (owner's responsibility to check) • There will be no loose parts/articles in the vehicle (radar detector, loose change, cups, floor mats, etc...) • Helmets are required. Must be SNELL/DOT approved and no older than year 2000. No motorcycle helmets allowed • Long sleeve cotton shirt and long pants or jeans • Enclosed toed shoes (preferably leather)
	Recommended Equipment (especially if a frequent participant) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rollbar or hardtop (especially on convertible cars) • Five or six point seat belt harnesses • In car fire extinguisher or active fire suppression recommended • Nomex driving suit • Head and neck restraint (HANS) • Driving gloves & driving shoes
