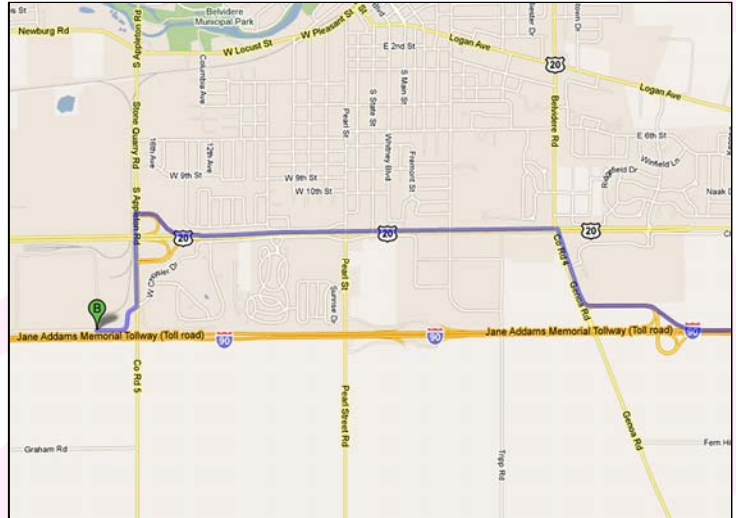




The next performance driving event is approaching: *Women's Day Driving Event*

Directions:

Coming From All Directions

- Take i90 and exit on Genoa Rd toward Belvidere
- Drive .6 miles and turn right at Co Rd 4/Genoa Rd
- Drive .3 miles and turn left at US-20 W
- Drive 1.7 miles and take the S Appleton Rd exit
- Drive .4 miles and turn left at S Appleton Rd/Stone Quarry Rd
- Drive .4 miles and turn right on W Chrysler Drive
- Drive .3 miles, you'll see autocross lot on the right

When You Arrive

- Turn into the autocross lot and drive straight ahead through to the Viper parking area.
- If you have a trailer, you can unload in the adjacent lot, but there should still be room in the Viper parking area on the autocross course
- There will be limited room for parking
- There will likely be many spectators at this event, we will confine them to a fenced area.

Overview: This event caters to all of our female club members of all ages. It's main focus is to teach our ladies how to drive a stick shift, how to handle a Viper (or the car they choose to bring), and how to drive an autocross course. It caters to all novice drivers. It is not a competitive event. This event in particular will be held at a new location - the Chrysler Assembly plant in Belvidere, Illinois. Gentlemen are free to come and watch/help. Due to this being an event that will likely draw spectators, we are allowing the men to also drive the course a bit so bring your cars. There is a strong possibility that we will also be approved for a plant tour! Stay tuned!

This event will take place in one of the large parking lots on the plant. This event will occur rain or shine (unless an extraordinary downpour occurs). Lodging is suggested above if you choose to arrive the night before. If you are towing your car, there will plenty of room to park tow vehicles and trailers right next to the autocross course. We have arranged to have port-o-potties available right near the course. Several large tents will be erected to keep us out of the hot sun. We will break for lunch just before 12:00pm. Lunch will be complimentary for everyone attending and will be provided at the venue. Several coolers will be on hand, water is free to everyone. Spectators are welcome at no charge.

Also Needed: Please fill out a registration form and mail the payment before the event. The registration form is available on the IL VCA website or it can be emailed to you. If it's very close to the event, contact us so we know you're coming, we can fill out the forms at the event. Advance registration is appreciated.

Helpful Info: Items that may make the event more enjoyable and comfortable may include sunglasses, hat, suntan lotion, towel, folding chair, and umbrella (for sun and rain). Other items that might be of use are tire pressure gauge, driving gloves, and driving shoes. At the event, there are many folks eager to lend a helping hand with anything if need!



Details:

This event will take our ladies on a stepped and enjoyable learning experience that will teach them the Viper (or any car) is not that hard to drive at its limits. For those who don't yet know how to drive stick, instruction will be on hand for them, we'll take all the time we need. There will also be little exercises setup in the lot, we know you'll like it. The exercises get the tires screeching in a controlled and safe environment. Instructors will be in all cars to teach you how to drive the car. Later in the afternoon, the exercises will be combined into a course, so everyone will get a chance to drive a full autocross course. No helmet will be required for this event (though you're free to use one). Everyone is also required to wear closed toed shoes (you can however wear short sleeved shirts and short pants). When you arrive, simply check-in and we'll take it from there! The entire event is free, lunch is free too. You'll have a great time!
